Non-winners of \$35,000 allowed 2 lbs.; a race other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, June 14, 2003 with 27 Nominations.

PRETTY WILD AGAIN was steadied while between rivals entering the turn, chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. KORSAKOFF was pinched back at the start, raced wide and tired in the stretch. BEST TO BE KING was hustled outside, chased the pace and was finished early. SNOW EAGLE dropped back early and was outrun.
